- Please use portable stoves rather than open fires for cooking.
- Please only build fires in designated places at approved campsites. Maine law forbids fires in undesignated areas.
- Please carry in and carry out all litter. Leave the site better than you found it.
- Please camp at designated campsites to prevent unnecessary resource damage.
